Bodø is a cruise destination eager to be discovered. Although a major port of call for the Norwegian Coastal Steamer, Bodø has not pursued the cruise industry for the last decade. However we are thrilled to present Bodø as an exciting and fascinating cruise destination. We can accommodate virtually all cruise ships and offer a great variety of shore ex for all ages, all group sizes and all activity levels. Among shore ex highlights are the world famous Saltstraumen - the world's strongest maelstrom; the Norwegian Aviation Museum -Scandinavia's largest and most modern; Kjerringøy - picturesque historic trading post; Svartisen - the Black Ice Glacier is Norway's second largest.

ATTRACTIONS/ EXCURSIONS

Sightseeing to Saltstraumen

Distance: 32 km. / 30 min. by bus
 Duration: 4 hours. Capacity: 12-400.
 Saltstraumen, the world's strongest tidal current, rises every six hours when enormous masses of salt water pass at speeds of up to 20 knots through a 3 km-long, 150 m- wide sound. Saltstraumen is famous for its abundance of fish, including cod, saithe, wolf fish and halibut. Traces of 10 000 year-old human habitations have been found here.

Kjerringøy trading post

Distance: 40 km. / 60 min. by bus and car-ferry
 Duration: 4-5 hours. Capacity: 10-350.
 A trip to Kjerringøy through magnificent nature! A unique insight into the coastal culture of northern Norway. Experience how both masters and servants lived in a late 17th century commercial spot.

Experience Svartisen - the Black Ice Glacier

Distance: 175 km. / 180 min. by bus
 Duration: 5-8 hours. Capacity: 12-100.
 Walk on Norway's second largest glacier or simply watch it up close and personal. An incredible experience and sight.

Norwegian Aviation Museum

Distance: 2 km. / 5 min. by bus
 Duration: 1-2 hours. Capacity: 1000.
 One of Europe's most marvelous exhibitions, split into a civil and a military wing. Military aircraft like the Spitfire, CF-104 Starfighter, Ju 88 and the U-2 spy plane. Sloggers and passenger planes like the Ju 52, Twin Otter and F28.

Visiting a Sami Camp by helicopter

Distance: 2 km. / 5 min. bus to airport
 Duration: 3-4 hours. Capacity: 10.
 Helicopter lift to the Black Ice Glacier and onwards to a reindeer herd on Saltfjellet where you learn about a Sami family's everyday life, struggles, herd moving etc.

Deep Sea Rafting / Sea Eagle Safari

From quayside, by boat
 Duration: 2 hours. Capacity: 12-100.
 When boarding your RIB, your captain will take you on an exhilarating ride along the dazzling fjord. Enjoy the surrounding landscape of steep cliffs, snow-capped peaks and cascading waterfalls as you whizz across the water to discover the natural environment of the eagle.

"Stone age trip" to Tuvsjyen

Distance: 35 km. / 40 min. by bus
 Duration: 4 hours. Capacity: 40.
 In this area there are traces of 10 000 year-old human habitation. Experience an exciting breath from the stone age around the bonfire in the Lavvu.

Sightseeing

From quayside, by bus or walking
 Duration: 1-2 hours. Capacity: 10-100.
 A tour around the city by bus. Includes most sights.

Fishing trip and visit to Landegode Lighthouse

From quayside, by boat
 Duration: 4-5 hours. Capacity: 10-60.
 An original lighthouse placed right at the mouth of the fjord.

Golf in the Midnight Sun

Distance: 12 km. / 12 min. by bus
 Duration: 4 hours. Capacity: 40.
 This 18-hole golf course stretches all the way into the beach just north of the Arctic Circle.

Walk-about / City sightseeing with guide

By bus or walking
 Duration: 2 hours. Capacity: 30-60.
 A walk-about in the city area, with an explanation of architectural principles and development in Bodø.

Guided gallery visit

From quayside, walking
 Duration: 2 hours Capacity: 30-60.
 A visit to some of the many galleries and art exhibitions in Bodø.

Keiservarden - a guided tour to one of Bodø's most famous observation points

Distance: 6 km. / 25 min. by bus
 Duration: 1-2 hours. Capacity: 10-100.
 Keiservarden, the Emperor's Peak. A phenomenal 360° panoramic view of the mountains surrounding the city and the Lofoten Islands.

Tour the mines and visit the Mine Museum in Sultjelma

Distance: 100 km. / 95 min. by bus
 Duration: 6-7 hours. Capacity: 10-100.
 Visit the kingdom of the mountain man in the visitors' mine. Put on miners' clothing and follow the mine engine 0.9 miles into the mountain.

Diving trip to Saltstraumen

From quayside, by boat
 Duration: 5 hours. Capacity: 20.
 The National Geographic has placed Saltstraumen on its top-10 list of diving destinations. In other words, on of the best diving spots in the world!

Guided tour of Nyholmen Skanse

Distance: 4 km. / 10 min. by bus
 Duration: 1 hour. Capacity: 40-150.
 The 200-year old Nyholmen Skanse lies in the approach to Bodø, strategically placed to guard the city from battleships during the Napoleonic wars.

Cave trip

Distance: 40 km. / 60 min. by bus
 Duration: 3-6 hours. Capacity: 5-80.
 An unusual and exciting experience of silence and darkness.

Hang gliding and paragliding above the Arctic Circle

Distance: 5 km. / 20 min. by bus
 Duration: 2-4 hours. Capacity: 1-5.
 Fly with an instructor in a tandem paraglider from Keiservarden (Emperor's Peak) to a beachside landing at Løp. Sometimes a Sea Eagle will soar along the mountains with you.

It is possible to combine different excursions. All the trips include necessary equipment, such as warm suits, hats and gloves.
