Harstad is the city of the largest island in Norway, Hinnøya, the gateway island in the Lofoten and Vesteraalen archipelago. With 24 000 inhabitants, our town is the cultural capital of Northern Norway. We have available a wide variety of tailor-made and theme-based excursions within walking distance or easy travel arrangements from our cruise port, when visiting Harstad. Our guides are highly competent and will do their very best to make your excursion an unforgettable experience.

The Trondenes Peninsula

Duration: 3.5 hrs
Capacity: 10 - 500 pax
The Trondenes Peninsula is historically important; it was once the seat of a Viking Chief and later it was occupied by the Germans during World War II. Visit the world's northernmost stone church, the Trondenes Church, dating back to the late middle ages (1250). A short walk from the church you will

find Trondenes Historical Centre, where its exhibition takes us from the Viking ages to the present day. Further up the hill lies the Adolf Gun - one of the world's largest land based canons - and the world's only fully restored fortification. It has a barrel measuring 40.6 in diameter.

The green community - Kvæfjord

Duration: 5 hrs
Capacity: 10 - 120 pax
In the lush countryside of Kvæfjord you will find the Rå Gardening School, with plants specially adapted to the Arctic climate. You can visit Hemmestad Wharf which is a former trading post where time has stood still for almost 200 years. In Kvæfjord you will also find the Trastad Collection, where you can visit an authentic residential and care facility from 1966. Today the institution is a museum; visit a unique

collection of art in the only gallery in Norway exhibiting art created by people with mental disabilities. We recommend having lunch at the beautiful Røkenes Farm, dating back to 1750, before returning to your ship.

Polar Park

Duration: 6 hrs
Capacity: 15 - 250 pax
Visit the world's northernmost Zoo with a rich display of local Arctic wildlife. The biggest tourist attraction at Polar Zoo is the Wolf Camp, where you can meet the wolves inside the enclosure. It is also possible for families with children to meet polar foxes inside the enclosure; an unforgettable experience.

Hiking to Keipen (Aune) - breathtaking view

Duration: 3.5 hrs
Capacity: 10 - 180 pax
Enjoy the magnificent view from the top of Mount Aune (490 m above sea level). The guide will make an open fire, serve real Norwegian "fire coffee" and offer something to eat. This is an easy walk and is therefore suitable for all ages. Remember to bring your camera; from the top plateau the mountain descends steeply into the ocean.

Guided day trip to the Lofoten Islands

Duration: 8 hrs
Capacity: 15-200 pax
From Harstad we travel south through the historical and beautiful Tjeldsundet strait. On our way, we pass the old trading post Sandtorgholmen from the 15th century. North of Lødingen we head westwards for 18 km before entering "LOFAST" - the mainland connection of Lofoten. From here we drive towards Fiskebøl and Svolvær. The nature is dramatic and wild in one of Norway's most important fishing ports. In

Svolvær we pay "Magic Ice» a visit - ice bar and gallery, where you can look at ice art and coastal culture while enjoying some refreshments. After lunch we head back towards Harstad, and you get another chance to enjoy the magnificent nature of the Lofoten Islands.

Snow Fun

Duration: 4 hrs
Capacity: 10 - 200 pax
Go to the summit of Mount Sollia by snow-cat, then sled down the side of the mountain. The visit also includes playing a game of curling with natural stones and taking part in a toboggan race. A warm lunch is prepared over the fire in a lavvo (traditional Sami tent).

Aurora Borealis in Sami

Duration: 3-4 hrs
Capacity: 10-200 pax
At Aun we have our lavvo camp, a 800 sq m big arena surrounded by snow, mountains and sea. Inside the

lavvo you can keep warm by the big bonfire. The location provides an excellent opportunity to see the Northern Lights. We serve special Aurora Cocktails in ice glasses and you can have a taste of our "Aurora Wild chips", dried reindeer meat.

Viking chieftain Tore Hund's empire

Duration 3-5 hrs
Capacity: 8 - 24 pax
A RIB takes you from Harstad to Sundsvoll strait to Bjarkøy. Learn about the geography, nature and history of the area, such as the seat of chieftain Tore Hund at Øvergården in Nergårdshavn. We make a short stop in the Sundsvoll strait so that you can get to know the kittiwakes and eagles on bird rock. Light lunch is served in "Midgard". Coffee or tea included. Good footwear suitable for the time of year is recommended. Your camera is an absolute must on this trip!
