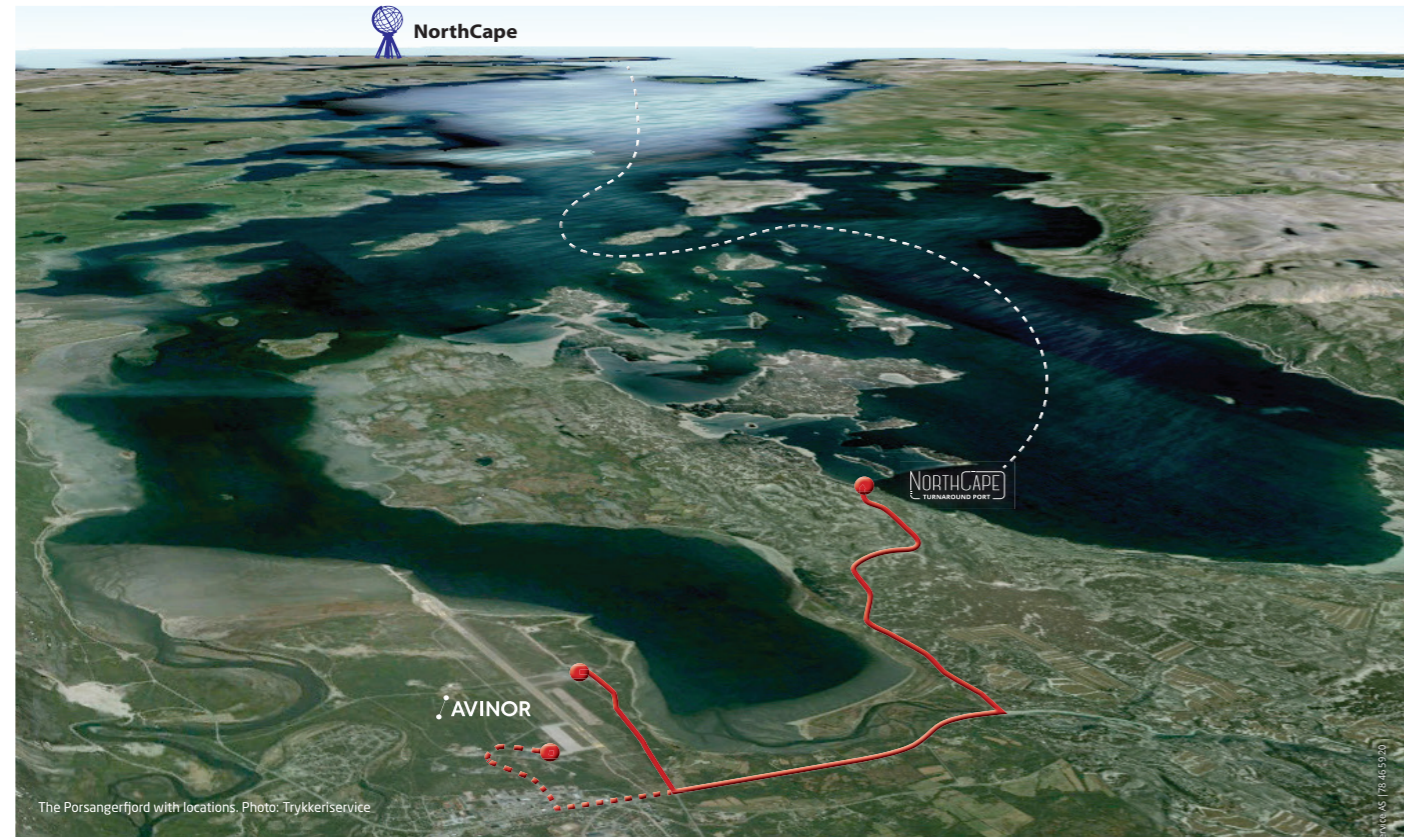

NORTH CAPE TURNAROUND PORT

The Gateway to the land of the Midnight Sun & Sápmi

The Arctic Porsanger Fjord is the 4th longest fjord in Norway and consists of numerous small islands and exciting attractions. Often called “the world’s northernmost archipelago”. Here is the northernmost canyon and the world’s northernmost pine forest. A large dolomite belt that creates amazing formations and rare plant life. Very good opportunities for bird watching in nature reserves. Three salmon rivers as well as over 4000 lakes. Thus, a true gem of nature to discover in the land of the Midnight Sun! North Cape International Airport is only 10 minutes away from the harbour, with very few restrictions. An obvious starting point for exploring the region. Especially with the Sámi way of life and culture only a short drive away.

ATTRACTIONS/ EXCURSIONS

“The Sámi’s 8 seasons”

Duration: 3 hours. Capacity: 20-40
 At Stabburnes Naturhus & Museum you get an understanding of the Sámi’s 8 seasons through a fantastic film which gives an insight into Sámi traditions in the course of a year. The exhibition at the national park centre displays the interaction between nature and culture in the area. In our lavvu, you will experience the flavour of our traditions.

“Hiking with a taste of Sámi culture”

Duration: 3 hours. Capacity: 20-40
 The tour starts from Stabburnes Naturhus & Museum. The trek is out against Stabburnes nature reserve, important wetlands for birds. Along the way, you get a taste of the Sámi culture in an atmospheric setting and you will be served a “local taste of snack”, by the fire in a lavvu. There will also be storytelling about Sámi’s use of the area.

Trollholmsund - Hiking Tour

Duration: 3 hours. Capacity: 20-40
 At a visit to Trollholmsund - an area of some beautiful stone dolomite formations - you will hear about an old Sámi legend, which tells of a group of wandering trolls and how they were turned into stone. A marked trail passes through an agricultural landscape, with an incredible wealth of biodiversity and interesting sights.

Riddoduottarmuseat / RDM Porsanger Museum

Duration: 2 hours. Capacity: 20-40
 Presenting Sámi, Kven and Norwegian cultural history and collection relating to industries such as fishing and agriculture, households and everyday life.

Fossestrand Farm and Handcraft Shop

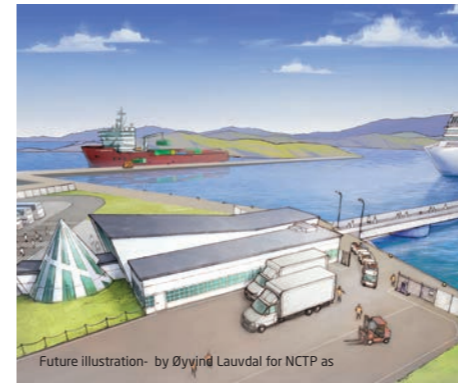
Duration: 30 min - 1 hour. Capacity: 20-40
 Produces Sámi handcraft as well as products made from local herbs and berries. Here one can also meet the sheep and lamas. Hot drinks are served on request.

ATW Safaris to Caskil

Duration: 3.5 hours. Capacity: 20. For all ATW-drivers: a car driving licence is required
 From the port in Hamnbukt the drive goes up to the Caskil viewpoint. Several photo stops along the road, including a visit to Fossestrand Farm and the handcraft shop. Hot drinks can be included. The tour ends at Hamnbukt.

Riddoduottarmuseat / RDM Sámi Museum - in the Sámi village Karasjok

Duration: 3 hours. Capacity: 20-40
 This is the largest Sámi museum in Norway, with one of the world’s largest collections of traditional Sámi clothing, from different areas and time periods. Outdoors there are several different Sámi buildings, some comprising a unique farmsteads and a several thousand year old hunting construction for wild reindeer.



Riverboat excursion with Sámi folklore in Lavvu Camp - in the Sámi village of Karasjok
 Duration: 4 hours. Capacity: 20-40
 You will take part in a rare experience that is not to be found many places on the northern hemisphere. Taking part in a trip on a riverboat! In Karasjok, this is still a vibrant culture! In the boat on the way you can stretch out your hand over the gunwale and touch the water. A cool feeling! On shore again you will visit a Lavvu Camp with Sámi folklore and a Sámi meal.

«A touch of Sápmi» in the Sámi village of Karasjok

Duration: 5 hours. Capacity: 20-40
 At the Sámi Museum, you will experience an exhibition that imparts a love of interpretation through art, and also describes the Sámi’s courtship and wedding customs. You will also take part in a rare experience that is not to be found many other places in the northern hemisphere. To ride on a river boat! On shore again you will visit a Lavvu Camp with Sámi folklore and a Sámi meal.



The Norwegian Sámi Parliament in the Sámi village Karasjok
 Duration: 3-4 hours. Capacity: 20-40
 The Norwegian Sámi Parliament is an elected institution for the Sámi population in Norway. It is shaped in a semicircle on two floors. At the end of the semicircle is the Sámi Parliament’s plenary hall as a teepee style amphitheatre for meetings of the Sámi Parliament. The building stands primarily as a concrete symbol of the political and legal status of the Sámi as a people.

Sápmi Park - in the Sámi village of Karasjok

Duration: 4 hours. Capacity: 60-200
 The cultural park presents the Sámi culture and history in an enthralling, informative and entertaining way. Watch reindeer up close, enjoy a magic film about Sámi culture, try lassoing, visit a Sámi camp or buy authentic Sámi handicrafts. Sápmi Park also offers the option of tasty Sámi food in “Storgammen” Restaurant.



Engholm Husky Farm - outside the Sámi village of Karasjok
 Duration: 3-4 hours. Capacity: 20-40
 Share the wonderful enthusiasm of the Alaskan Husky and come to understand the special relationship between musher and dog. Visit the puppy-yard and linger with the friendly adult racing dogs. You don’t need to be a passionate dog-lover to gain respect and admiration for these hard working dogs and their qualities.

Sightseeing in the Sámi village of Karasjok

Duration: 30 min - 1 hour. Capacity: 20-200
 Combine with all the visits and activities, where you will get the up close view of some of the attractions and learn something of Karasjok’s history.
