Get ready for the North Cape - a monumental cliff plunging into the endless Arctic Ocean. This is the adventure of a lifetime. In previous centuries a journey for explorers and expeditions, today a major destination for visitors from all over the world. Enjoy the Northern Lights and the soft glow of the Midnight Sun. Engage in exciting activities and explore spectacular nature. Frozen shores and snow-capped mountains in winter, a coastline rich in wildlife and history. Endless daylight and haunting landscapes in summer. Visit the northernmost part of continental Europe - visit the North Cape.

ATTRACTIONS/EXCURSIONS

The North Cape

Duration: 3-4 hours. Capacity: 6000
The North Cape is known as Europe's northernmost point, located at a latitude of 71°10'21". On the massive cliff you can visit North Cape Hall, a tourist center with a host of facilities, representing the final frontier with the Arctic Sea. In the hall you find exhibitions, souvenir store, cafeteria and restaurant, restrooms and much more. You can also enjoy a beautiful film from the local area, shown in the supervideo. Open all year.

Bird Safari

- The Number Two Attraction at the North Cape
Duration: 3.5-4 hours. Capacity: 147
Take advantage of your moment in the north to experience one of Europe's greatest and most accessible sanctuaries for Atlantic seabirds. Be dazzled by millions of birds breeding and living at the Gjesværsstappan Nature Reserve.

King Crab Safari by boat

Duration: 3 hours. Capacity: 4-40
Enjoy deep sea rafting in Sarnesfjord and participate in catching your own King Crab. Learn about the history of this famous creature and how to prepare it.

King Crab Safari by bus

Duration: 2.5 hours. Capacity: 60
We welcome you to experience King Crab live at our lavvo camp in Sarnes. Learn about the life of these famous creatures and how to prepare them.

ATV Safari

Duration: 1.5 hours/Capacity: 4-10
Experience the Magerøya Island's unique nature with many stops for photos at stunning viewpoints over the island and Honningsvåg. Driver's license for car required for drivers.

Artico Ice Bar

Duration: 30-60 min/Capacity: 50
By the harbor. A bar made of ice from the lakes of

Magerøya Island. Walls, tables, igloo, seats, and the screen where we show images of the Arctic. Enjoy the polar winter in summer!

The North Cape Museum

Duration: 30-60 min/Capacity: 100.
By the harbor. Presentation of Arctic fisheries and local history of the North Cape area.

Once Upon a Dream Gallery and gift shop

Capacity: 1-50
A beautiful gallery situated near the harbor in Honningsvåg. The Gallery exhibits beautiful art and handicrafts from the surrounding district made by the artist Erica Haugli from America.

Honningsvåg Church

Duration: 30-60 min. Capacity: 100.
Walking distance from the harbor.
Only building left after Second World War.

The excursion to the North Cape includes a visit to a Sami "siida" (camp) where we will meet a Sami Family. The guide will talk about local and Sami history, traditions and lifestyle. Optional services can be arranged.

The Photo Safari gives you more than through-the-bus-window shooting opportunities. It will help you discover hidden treasures, and take you off the beaten track.
