## The northernmost point

Breathtaking scenery, picturesque fishing villages and the captivating light of the Arctic. Get ready for the stunning journey to the extreme north of Europe. Get ready for the North Cape - a monumental cliff plunging into the endless Arctic Ocean. This is the adventure of a lifetime. In previous centuries a journey for explorers and expeditions, today a major destination for visitors from all over the world. Enjoy the Northern Lights and the soft glow of the Midnight Sun. Engage in exciting activities and explore spectacular nature. Frozen shores and snow-capped mountains in winter, a coastline rich in wildlife and history. Endless daylight and haunting landscapes in summer. Visit the northernmost part of continental Europe - visit the North Cape.

### ATTRACTIONS/EXCURSIONS

#### Hornvika - the North Cape Classic - NEW!

Duration: 5 hours/Capacity 12  
Conquer the North Cape the classic way. Boat from Skarsvåg, historical Exhibition, sampling of local food, enter the North Cape Hall and champagne to celebrate.

#### The North Cape café teatre - NEW!

Duration: 35 min/Capacity: 65  
How on earth can you settle down and enjoy life at 71° north. A group of local young artists give you the surprising answer. The show takes place in Perleporten kulturhus (the Pearly Gates House of Culture) in the centre of Honningsvåg with a view over the harbour.

#### The North Cape

Duration: 3-4 hours. Capacity: 6000  
Europe's northernmost point, located at a latitude of 71°10'21". On the massive cliff you can visit North Cape Hall, a tourist centre with a host of facilities

- supervideoograf, Cave of Light, exhibitions, souvenir store, cafeteria and restaurant, restrooms and much more. Open all year.

#### Bird Safari

Duration: 3.5-4 hours. Capacity: 147  
Experience one of Europe's greatest and most accessible sanctuaries for Atlantic seabirds. Be dazzled by millions of birds breeding and living at the Gjesværsstappan Nature Reserve.

#### King Crab Safari by boat

Duration: 3 hours. Capacity: 4-40  
Enjoy deep sea rafting in Sarnesfjord and participate in catching your own King Crab. Learn about the history of this famous creature and how to prepare it.

#### King Crab Safari by bus

Duration: 2.5 hours. Capacity: 60  
We welcome you to experience King Crab live at our lavvo camp in Sarnes. Learn about the life of these famous creatures and how to prepare them.

#### ATV Safari

Duration: 1.5 hours/Capacity: 4-10  
Experience the Magerøya Island's unique nature with stops for photos at stunning viewpoints over the island and Honningsvåg.

#### Artico Ice Bar

Duration: 30-60 min/Capacity: 50  
A bar made of ice from the lakes of Magerøya Island. Enjoy the polar winter in summer!

#### The North Cape Museum

Duration: 30-60 min/Capacity: 100  
Presentation of Arctic fisheries and local history of the North Cape area.

#### Once Upon a Dream Gallery and gift shop

Capacity: 1- 50  
The Gallery exhibits beautiful art and handicrafts from the surrounding district made by the artist Erica Haugli from America.

#### Honningsvåg Church

Duration: 30-60 min. Capacity: 100  
Only building left after the Second World War.

#### The Gallery "East of the Sun"

Capacity: 50  
Exhibits beautiful art and handicrafts from the surrounding district made by the artist Eva Schmutterer.

#### North Cape Christmas and Winter House

Capacity: 50  
A house decorated with handmade crafts, all genuine Norwegian products. Stories from life in Northern Norway.

#### Guided Fishing Village Tour

Duration: 3 hours. Capacity: 400  
Experience daily life and fishing activities in the local community, and learn about the island of Magerøya in general. Visit the local gallery and Christmas House, among others.

#### Walking Tour in the town of Honningsvåg

Duration: 2 hours. Capacity: 15 per guide  
Here the main theme is life in Honningsvåg - in both a historical and a current perspective. Includes a visit to Honningsvåg Church.

#### Visit to a Sami Camp "Siida"

Duration: 2-4 hours. Capacity: 100  
Visit to a Sami camp where we will meet a Sami family. The guide will talk about local and Sami history, traditions and lifestyle.

#### Photo safari

Duration: 3 hours. Capacity: 1-50  
The Photo Safari gives you more than through-the-bus-window shooting opportunities. It will help you discover hidden treasures, and take you off the beaten track.
