# HAMMERFEST

## - the northernmost town in the world

Hammerfest welcomes you to the northernmost towns in the world! Hammerfest is a dynamic town, where contemporary architecture is replacing post-WWII reconstruction buildings. Visitors can experience Hammerfest with a stroll through the town or a visit to its museums. From the early "Pomor" trade with Russia, to a town completely lost in flames, a rich tradition of Arctic hunting and fishing; and, more recently, industrial development based on energy and gas: Hammerfest has a unique and fascinating history.

### ATTRACTIONS/EXCURSIONS

#### Hammerfest Sami Camp

Guided tour to visit the Sami camp "Mikkelgammen" Panoramic drive with stops/photo stops at Forsøl (fishing village), Mikkelgammen (with tastings) and Salen viewpoint. At Salen, you have a fantastic view over Hammerfest. Mikkelgammen is situated on the mountain Salen. Here we meet a Sami herding family and learn about their history, culture and everyday life. Samples of Sami food will be served: reindeer meat, smoked fish and cloudberry.

#### Finnmark Panoramic

The excursion starts at the pier in Hammerfest. We take a city tour in Hammerfest and make a stop at Mt.

n Salen, with its beautiful view over Hammerfest. On the way to Skaidi we pass Hammerfest Church, built in 1961. On this excursion you will experience Arctic nature and a beautiful coastal landscape. You will learn more about our history and the way of life up here. Coffee/tea will be served at Skaidi before we return to Hammerfest.

#### Hammerfest History and the Polar Bear Society

During this sightseeing tour we will pay a visit to the Polar Bear Society and the UNESCO Meridian Column with photo stop. At the Royal and Ancient Polar Bear Society you will have a unique opportunity to experience the town's proud traditions of fishing and hunting in the Arctic

areas. On this visit you will be able to join the Society and support WWF for the research into polar bears living in the Arctic region.

#### Hammerfest History and the Museum of Post-War Reconstruction

During this sightseeing tour we will pay a visit to the Museum of Post-War Reconstruction and the UNESCO Meridian Column with photo stop.

**The Museum of Reconstruction for Finnmark and North-Troms.** The exhibition aims to convey the poignancy of the dramatic events of WWII: the forced evacuation, the conflagration and the restoration. Never before has any war had such dire consequences for the people of our country.

#### The Energy House

In beautiful surroundings on the site of the first power station in Northern Europe (1891), where hydroelectricity for the street lights was produced, stands the Energy House. In this new and interactive center, you will have the opportunity of experiencing technology for the production of different energy sources like wind, tidal water and LNG (gas). You will also see a short movie in the Energy House.

#### Hiking Tour

This is a walk for the experienced hiker. We start off in the center, passing through the town and the church before we walk up Gamleveien (The Old Trail). This is followed by a steep climb up the mountain. As we reach the top of Salen (The Saddle), we walk through a small forest and end up in the café Turistua. Here we stop for some refreshments and enjoy a spectacular view over Hammerfest. The tour then continues down Sikk-sakk-veien (The Zig-zag trail) and back to the ship.

#### North Cape

On this trip from Hammerfest to the North Cape you will experience Arctic nature at the coastline and in the inland. Our guide will tell you about life in this area. We will cross some bridges and pass through various tunnels and see some areas where the

reindeer make their way to the coast. It can be a full day tour or a half day tour. It is possible to stop at Skaidi for a small meal.

#### Fish Camp Hammerfest
