NARVIK

The region of contrast

Welcome to Narvik - A peninsula surrounded by fjords and mountains. Narvik is so much more than just beautiful nature! It is the home of Ofoten railway, the navvies, the famous bears Salt & Pepper and its unique war history. It was the first industrial town in Northern Norway and was given town status in 1902 as the construction of the Ofoten Railway was completed. A town centre was formed and its unique culture was, and still is, influenced by Swedish navvies, British engineers and sailors from across the world. Located 45 km from the Swedish border you can visit two countries in one day.

ATTRACTIONS/EXCURSIONS

Polar Park

The world's northernmost wildlife park and one of Northern Norway's most popular tourist attractions. With its 114 acres of natural habitat it houses Arctic animals such as wolves, brown bear, lynx, wolverine, moose, reindeer, musk oxen and fox. Enjoy a guided tour of the park.

Why not try a different kind of visit?

- Wolf Camp

We give you the unique opportunity to meet the wolves at Polar Park inside the enclosure! Meet this mythical animal, and discover the actual truth about wolves.

- Howl night (winter)

Join us and get a unique and fantastic experience after closing time. Close your eyes and imagine standing in the park. It is dark, crispy snow underfoot, you are calling the wolves and they reply. This is the perfect setting for the Northern Lights to magically light up the sky.

The Ofoten Railway

The Ofoten Railway extends for 42 km from Narvik to the Swedish border and winds its way through steep, rugged, mountainous terrain north of the Arctic Circle. The journey is a tourist attraction in itself. The line was once described as the 8th Wonder of the World and was the northernmost, coldest and harshest railway construction project the world had ever seen.

- Combination tour Ofotbanen Railway, navy trek and RIB

In a rich and wild nature setting the Navy Trail winds its way down from the mountain to the fjord. The framework for this picturesque walk is nature itself with vibrant colours, brilliant light and unique sounds. The Navy Trail has been branded a cultural heritage trail.

- Combination tour Ofotbanen Railway & Polar Park
The two most sought after excursions in one package.

Narvikfjellet

Narvikfjellet offers activities both summer and winter. Spectacular views from the Mountain Restaurant. The cable car brings you to an altitude of 656 metres above sea level in just 7 minutes.

- The newest attraction Linken Climbing Park is great fun for the entire family. At the Park you can challenge yourself and your own limits while having fun in secure environments.

War History & Memorial Museum

Narvik's dramatic history from World War II. For two months a bitter battle for Narvik and the iron-ore raged between the invading German forces and the French, Polish and Norwegian troops on land, and a considerable British flotilla at sea. The Battle of Narvik was the first major victory gained by the Allies during World War II, thanks to the powerful support of the Royal Navy. The museum's exhibits document the period 1940-1945 and contain an original enigma machine and a Victoria Cross.

Tinja Mountain Lodge

Tinja Mountain Lodge is a unique gourmet restaurant that prides itself on homemade cooking using only local ingredients. Tinja is a natural stop on the road to Sweden, so any combination of train/bus or bus/bus is ideal.

- Beer tasting

Tinja have set up a microbrewery in the basement and they invite you to join in a beer tasting session. Their beer has been given great reviews and is served with some local snacks.

- Gourmet tour

Tinja Mountain Lodge is run by descendants of the Svonni people and is built on old Sami land. Their food philosophy is built on a simple, but solid foundation where taste is the essence, using local raw materials such as grouse, char, berries, herbs etc.

Jukkasjärvi Ice Hotel

The world's first and largest ice hotel. Day trip, stay overnight, get married, Northern Lights excursions.

Dog sledding

Glide across the blanket of snow to the sound of the runners and the panting of the dogs

In the footsteps of the iron-ore

Enjoy the magnificent train ride from Narvik to Kiruna, where most of the iron-ore is mined. The mines are as large as cities. You will be taken on a bus tour 1.4 km underground in the mines which also host an exhibition. Leaving Kiruna on a coach back to Narvik the tour ends at LKAB's port terminal where all the iron-ore is shipped from.

Hiking trek to Forsnesvannet (Tøttatoppen)

Tøttatoppen is one of Narvik's most famous peaks, and in order to be considered a true Narvikian you must have climbed this mountain. It is located to the east of the town centre and stretches 1234 metres above sea level.

Panoramic Skjomen (summer only)

Skjomen is known for its scenic and volcanic terrain with high, steep mountains, and clear water. Skjomtind, Reintind, and Klubbviktind are three of the many staggering mountains surrounding the fjord. The Frostisen glacier, which is one of the larger plateau glaciers in Norway, is located just west of the fjord.

RIB Narvik - Skjomen

Experience the thrill of riding a RIB. Skjomen has a site of about 80 rock carvings near the sea. It's believed that the rock carvings were made by the Fosna-Hensbacka culture, a Mesolithic culture from around 5000 BC. The rock carvings were discovered in the 1930s and you will be able to view some of these up close from the RIB.
