# TROMSØ

## - the city for summer and winter activities in the Arctic

Above the Arctic Circle, at 69°N, midway between the Lofoten Islands and the North Cape, is Tromsø, an experienced and well-functioning cruise destination. Amid some of Norway's most fascinating coast and fjord landscapes, it constitutes one of the most awe-inspiring cruise ports. The number of attractions offered in Tromsø prevents congestion, and the compactness and good infrastructure of the city allows for flexibility when organizing shore excursions. When calling at Tromsø, guests and staff feel welcome and in good hands.

### ATTRACTIONS/EXCURSIONS

#### The Arctic Cathedral

Distance: 2 km from city center  
Duration: 25 min. Capacity: 200  
North Norwegian nature, culture and faith inspired this cathedral built in 1965, with its architecture resembling ice and snow. The Arctic Cathedral is the iconic symbol of Tromsø.

#### Midnight Sun Concert in the Arctic Cathedral

Distance: 2 km from city center  
Duration: 30 min. Capacity: 200  
Evocative Midnight Sun Concert in the Arctic Cathedral every evening from 11:30 pm until midnight.

#### Polaria

Distance: In the city center  
Duration: 1 hour. Capacity: 200  
National information and adventure center focusing on the Polar Regions. Experience the panorama film from Spitsbergen, polar travel, aquarium with Arctic sea mammals, including live seals and exhibitions on polar research.

#### The Cable Car

Distance: 10 min by bus from the city center

Duration: 1 hour. Capacity: 27 per ride  
Take the cable car up to Mount Storsteinen (421 m) for a fantastic view. The Tromsø Island and surrounding waterways and mountains leaves you breathless.

#### Tromsø Wilderness Center

Distance: 30 min drive from Tromsø  
Duration: 1-2 hours. Capacity: 200  
Enjoy a walk with one of 300 friendly Alaskan huskies in the beautiful countryside just outside Tromsø.

#### Mack Brewery, Ølhallen

Distance: In the city center  
Duration: 1 hour. Capacity: 50  
"You haven't been in Tromsø if you haven't been to Ølhallen!" Enjoy a guided tour and a pint at the visiting center of the northernmost brewery in the world.

#### Tromsø University Museum

Distance: 3 km from city center  
Duration: 1 hour. Capacity: 200  
The museum presents in-depth knowledge about the peoples of the Arctic and their history as well as the Northern Lights.

#### Polar Museum

Distance: In the city center  
Duration: 1 hour. Capacity: 100  
The museum tells the tale of fascinating Arctic exploration and daring hunting in the ice, all in an 1830 wooden wharf building.

#### Tromsø Architecture Walk

Distance: In the city center  
Duration: 45 min. Capacity: 20  
Take a guided walk and learn about Tromsø's architecture as it evolved through the various stylistic periods which have shaped the city's visual expressions we see today.  
The walk finishes at the Perspektivet Museum.

#### Tromsø Military Museum

Distance: 10 min drive from Tromsø  
Duration: 1 hour. Capacity: 50  
Display of military history at former German naval cannon battery. Exhibition on "Tirpitz" - the German battleship sunk by the Allies at Håkøy in Nov. 1944.

#### The Art Museum of Northern Norway

Distance: In the city center  
Duration: 1 hour. Capacity: Unlimited  
Art about and from Northern Norway, along with national art history and temporary exhibitions.

#### Blåst - World's Northernmost glass hut!

Distance: In the city center  
Duration: 1 hour. Capacity: 20  
Blåst is an open workshop where you can get a demonstration of how glass is made. Like magic, glass is formed into fantastic products that make great gifts.

#### Northern Lights Chase

Distance: From the city center/Breivika  
Duration: 4-7 hours. Capacity: Unlimited  
Join an exciting Northern Lights chase from Tromsø. The crew is on one specific mission: to take the guests wherever the chances are best to admire the magnificent Aurora Borealis.

#### Tromsø Lapland

Distance: 7 min drive from Tromsø  
Duration: 1-2 hours. Capacity: 100  
Are you curious about the historical and exciting culture of the Sami? Tromsø Lapland can offer you an unforgettable high quality experience. Get a glimpse of Sámi and local culture and history.

#### Botanical Garden

Distance: 5 min walk from Breivika  
Duration: As long as wanted. Capacity: Unlimited  
The world's Northernmost Botanic garden features, Arctic, Antarctic and alpine plants from all continents, along with perennials and herbs of traditional use.

#### Tromsø City Walk

Distance: In the city center  
Duration: 90 min. Capacity: 12 guests per guide  
A must-do activity loaded with tips that will enhance your Tromsø experience! Our passionate local guides take you on a walk through the city center. You will leave Tromsø with a better understanding of the history, culture and lifestyle of our chilly slice of paradise.

#### Sommarøy

Sommarøy is a fishing village 60 km west of Tromsø, set in beautiful coastal landscapes with beaches and spectacular mountains as a backdrop.
